"MY THREE ANGELS" opens on Friday, evening in the Crighton Theatre in Conroe at 8:00 p.m. and runs every Friday and Saturday from November 30th until December 16th with 2:00p.m. Sunday Matinees on December 9th & 16th. The show is based on the book "La Cuisine Des Angels" by Albert Husson.

It's Christmas Eve 1910 in French Guiana, where the temperature has graciously dipped below 104F. Three convicts hilariously come to the

aid of a family put upon by an evil minded cousin and cold hearted nephew. The three soft hearted felons set matters right using their own unique methods and become real life angles to the grateful family. Indeed, the convicts take over the family and the entire play with high energy and enthusiasm as they go about their business of making things right

for all, even if that means resorting to some unconventional methods.

The play was adapted twice to film. Once in 1955, as "We're No Angels," starring Humphrey Bogart, Peter Ustinov, Aldo Ray, Joan Bennett, Basil Rathbone and Leo G. Carroll. It was directed by Michael Curtiz, who had directed Bogart in Casablanca when both were under contract to Warner Brothers. It is one of the rare comedies that Bogart made. Paramount filmed the production at its Hollywood studios in VistaVision and Technicolor. It was based upon the play, "My Three Angels," written by

Samuel and Bella Spewack. In 1989, the play was adapted again with the plot retooled into We're No Angels, a comedy film directed by Neil Jordan starring Robert De Niro, Sean Penn and Demi Moore.
