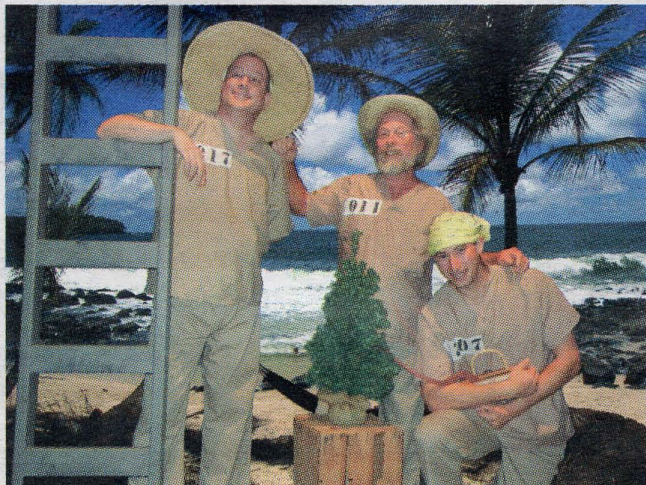


Stage Right Presents *My Three Angels* in the Crighton Theatre Nov. 30 - Dec. 16

Professional ventriloquists Phil and Melissa Nichols of Texas Vents will introduce youngsters to the art of ventriloquism and their hilarious cast of characters. Bravo Company, the Stage Right acting academy, will present a showcase of songs and monologues. The jolly old elf himself, Santa Claus, will be available for pictures. All this fun is only \$5/family (admission to be purchased at the door).

holiday show, Stage Right will be collecting new, unwrapped toys for donation to the Marine's Toys for Tots Campaign during the run of the show. The Toys for Tots program was founded in 1947 by reservist Major William L. Hendricks. Hendricks was inspired by his wife, Diane when she tried to donate a doll to a needy child but could find no organization to do so. Since beginning the U.S. Marine Corps Reserve Toys for Tots Program in 1947, Marines have distributed more than 452 million toys to more than 209 million needy children.
